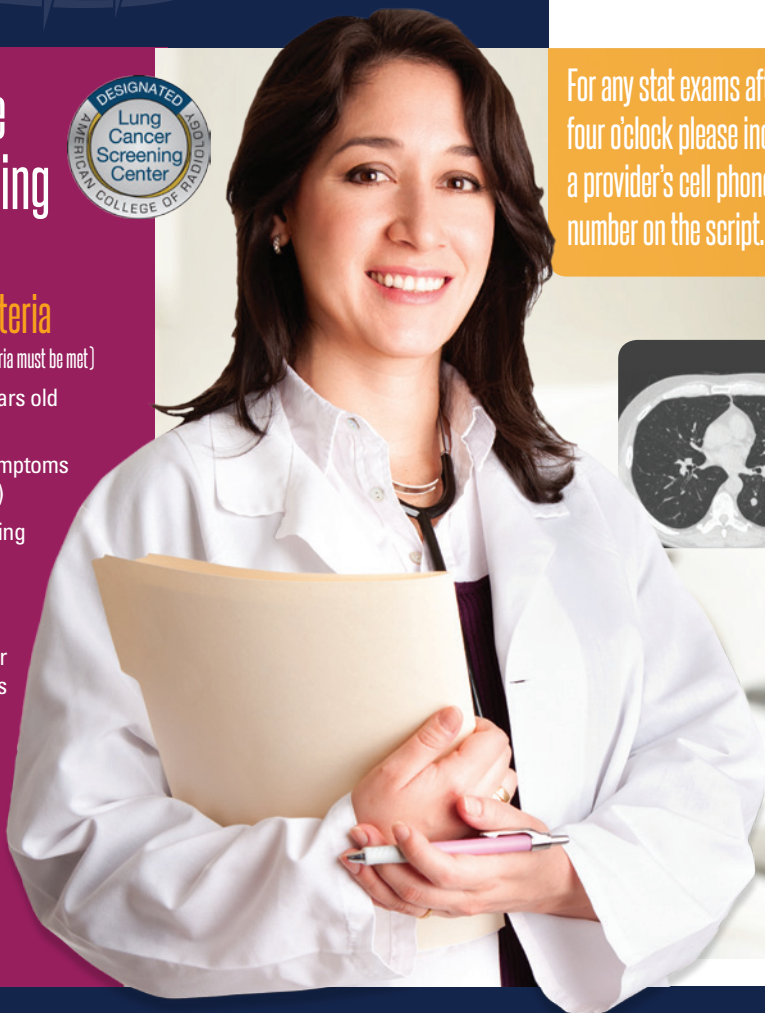

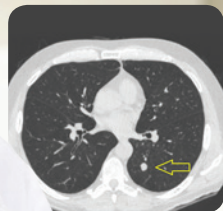
Beneficiary eligibility criteria

(All of the following criteria must be met)

- Age 55 – 77 years old
- Asymptomatic (no signs of symptoms of lung cancer)
- Tobacco smoking history of at least 30 pack years
- Current smoker or one who has quit smoking within the last 15 years
- Receives a written order for LDCT lung cancer screening

Where are the procedures performed?

Procedures are performed in our Northeast Medical Center, Fayetteville office. With the use of local anesthetic, it is performed comfortably in our outpatient setting.

What types of procedures are available for varicose veins?

- **Vein Ablation** – Guided by ultrasound, the laser or RF catheter, is inserted into the abnormal vein. As the laser is withdrawn it closes the vein. This is done without general anesthesia, sutures or down time.
- **Ambulatory Phlebectomy** is a non-invasive procedure to remove varicose vein branches by micro-extraction technique. Tiny incisions are made in the skin through which the remaining varicose veins are removed. The incisions are so small they do not require stitches, and often heal without scarring.
- **Injection Sclerotherapy** is the “Gold Standard” best treatment option for spider veins. Using a fine needle, a solution is injected to treat the spider veins. It is effective, less invasive, less painful and less expensive than some of the other procedures.
